Resolution of Representative Kidd Charges Temperance Committee With "Usurpation of Its Power" and "Wanted Searcy-Hixon, Bill Read This Year"

A resolution was introduced in the house by Representative Kidd of Baker Tuesday morning charging the temperance committee with usurpation of power, affecting the rights, dignity and integrity of its members through its action on the Searcy-Hixon bill of the senate.

The resolution, which was introduced just prior to the taking up of the automobile tax bill which was carried over from Monday, being in the presence of a privileged member, had the right of way over all other matter. It was not taken up until first read and referred to the committee on the day.

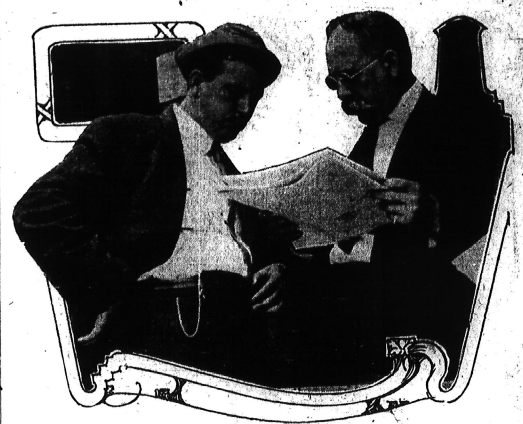
